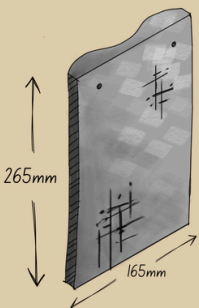


WINCHESTER BLEND

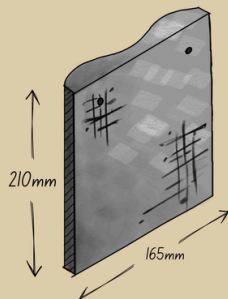

All three ranges share the same softly sanded surface, giving the blend a wonderfully cohesive feel even as the colours shift gently from tile to tile. Winchester Blend is a lovely choice for country houses, period restorations, and village properties where the roof should feel warm, characterful, and quietly rooted in its surroundings.

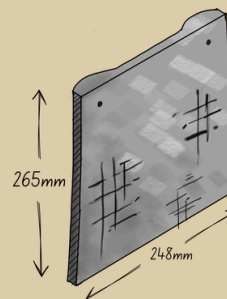

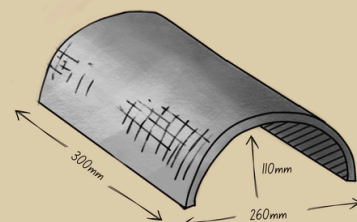
HOG BACK RIDGE

QUALITY CERTIFICATION

Spicer Tiles are tested by **LUCIDEON** (formerly CERAM) and have passed:

BSEN 538: 1994 for strength.

BSEN 539-2: 2005 for resistance to frost damage.

BSEN 539-1: 2006 for impermeability to water.

PLEASE NOTE: AS OUR TILES ARE INDIVIDUALLY HANDMADE USING TRADITIONAL METHODS, VARIATIONS IN COLOUR, SHADE, SURFACE TEXTURE, AND FINISH ARE ENTIRELY NATURAL AND TO BE EXPECTED. THESE SUBTLE DIFFERENCES ARE PART OF THE CHARACTER AND CHARM OF A GENUINE HANDMADE TILE, ENSURING THAT NO TWO ROOFS ARE EVER QUITE THE SAME.
